"You can open/load plugin and graph presets. But you cannot open 2d .cnsl files in 3d; things have changed too much. We may be able to build a translator in the future, but that tool does not exist at the present time".

I knew about the .cnsl files not opening. But the thing is my .aupresets don't open either (i am guessing they are audiounits) and i dont seem to have any other presets. Any way to download presets for my MIO Consolo plugs I bought? Thanx
